All new construction, demolition, renovations, septic systems, wells, and subdivisions REQUIRE a permit.

POOLS: Did you know that a fence is required if you own a pool? Either surrounding your yard or pool. TREE CUTTING: Did you know authorization is required

to cut trees within the 15m of protected waterfront zone (10m depending on the slope).

INSTALLING A TRAILER? Trailer by-law can be found on our website. Please inform the office once installed. Contact the office for more information.

DOG & CAT TAGS:

Does your pet have a tag? Tags are available at the Municipal Office. Tags are required to identify your pet should they be picked up by our Animal Control Officer.

Cost is \$20 and must be purchased annually.

OPEN-AIR FIRE DATES (without a fire pit): November 15 to March 15 of each year with a permit. Permits can be obtained from the Fire Chief.

FIREWORKS: Did you know that fireworks are only permitted during certain holidays? Victoria Day long weekend (May), Quebec National Day (June 24th), Canada Day (July 1), Civic Holiday weekend (August) and Labour Day weekend (Sept.).

OVERNIGHT PARKING: Did you know that you cannot park a vehicle overnight (midnight to 6AM) during the winter period (15 Nov. to 15 Apr.) on any municipal road, according to Municipal By-law 2016-12-09 and SQ By-law 2011-01? Please respect our NO PARKING signs and regulations. Also please be aware that you cannot push snow from your private driveways on to our municipal roads, this is extremely dangerous.

ENTRANCEWAYS / PRIVATE ROADS must be clear of all branches, trees and limbs 12' wide and 12' high, in order to allow emergency vehicles access to your property. (9-1-1 and Fire Services)

BOAT WASH The Municipality has installed a boat wash station behind the municipal hall at our municipal garage. It is now mandatory to wash your boat before launching it in one of our lakes. By-law 02-09-2020. (See website.)

PROJECTED DATES FOR ROAD CALCIUM APPLICATION: June and August (weather permitting)

TAX PAYMENTS: Due April 1, 2022. Payable in 3 instalments if the amount exceeds \$300.00, April 1, July 1 and September 1, 2022. Our system accepts postdated checks should you wish to send in your 3 instalments at once. Forms of payment accepted are **cash**, **check**, **debit** and online payments with most major banks.

POTABLE WATER: No longer accessible at the Pump House. Now available outside at the Municipal Office, 15 Palmer Avenue.

WASTE MANAGEMENT – Transfer Station Hours **April to October:** 8AM to 5PM Friday, Saturday, and Monday, 9AM to 6PM on Sunday.

November to March: 8AM to 5PM Friday,

Saturday, Sunday, and Monday.

FREE large waste disposal days:

June 4th & 5th, 2022. (One weekend only) NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS WILL BE ACCEPTED. **Recycling and Composting:**

The provincial Government will reduce our funding if we do not reduce our waste tonnage.

Increased recycling and composting reduces garbage tonnage and allows us to maintain our low waste service charges to the taxpayer.

Composting is easy to do: simply throw your leftover food scraps, coffee grounds/filters, tea bags, etc. into a biodegradable bag and bring it for dumping into the composting receptacle.
