DID YOU KNOW?

<u>PERMITS</u>: All new construction, demolition, renovations, septic systems, wells, decks, docks, pools and subdivisions **REQUIRE** a permit.

POOLS: A fence is required if you own a pool either surrounding your yard or pool.

TREE CUTTING: Authorization is required to cut trees within the 15m of protected waterfront zone (10m depending on the slope). Authorization is also required if you plan to cut trees on more than 2 hectares of land.

TRAILERS: Trailers require a permit. Trailer bylaw can be found on our website.

<u>DOG & CAT TAGS:</u> Does your pet have a tag? Tags are available at the Municipal Office. Tags are required to identify your pet should they be picked up by our Animal Control Officer. Cost is \$20 and must be purchased annually.

OPEN-AIR FIRE DATES (without a fire pit):

November 15 to March 15 of each year with a permit. Permits can be obtained from the Fire Chief.

FIREWORKS: Fireworks are only permitted during certain holidays? Victoria Day long weekend (May), Quebec National Day (June 24th), Canada Day (July 1), Civic Holiday weekend (August) and Labour Day weekend (Sept.) By-law 07-03-2012 (see website)

OVERNIGHT PARKING: You cannot park a vehicle overnight (midnight to 6AM) during the winter period (15 Nov. to 15 Apr.) on any municipal road, according to Municipal By-law 2016-12-09 and SQ By-law 2011-01? Please respect our NO PARKING signs and regulations.

BOAT WASHING: The Municipality has installed a boat wash station behind the municipal hall at our municipal garage. It is now mandatory to wash your boat before launching it in one of our lakes. By-law 02-09-2020. (See website)

Emergency Alert System - Telmatik

The system will immediately contact you by phone or e-mail of dangerous situations in the community. If you have never received such an alert you must contact the Municipal Office to register or register yourself on our Municipal website.
