Boat Washing Rules

- Remove water from live wells or compartments that hold water.
- Ensure all signs of plants attached Non-motorized crafts (e.g. paddle boards, canoes) must also be removed by the pressure washer. to the boat, motor and trailer are washed (free of charge).
- Boats moved to another body of before launching. water must be washed again

Enforcement

- Fines shall be levied for individuals not complying with the by-law. www.otterlakequebec.ca/bylaws
- Boat wash station and launch areas are monitored.
